Conditions of Entry

1. These rules and conditions relate only to the annual Audio Visual Competition.
2. Digital sequences will be copied onto a hard drive for presentation purposes on the competition day.
3. Digital sequences must not have been entered as 35mm slides in previous AV Competitions.
4. Sequences may be retained for inclusion in the L&CPU Archive and used for publicity purposes.

Rules for competition

1. Entries must reach the L&CPU AV Competition Secretary by 26th January 2020.
2. Entries will be on a club basis and must not have been shown previously in the L&CPU AV Competition.
3. There is no limit to the number of entries per club however, the entry form must list the entries in order of priority for showing. This is in case number of entries exceed the available competition time.
4. **The duration of a sequence must not exceed 12 min.**
5. The individual sequences must have Copyright clearance for both images and music and the author obtained the necessary licenses.
6. The production must be the original work of the Author and declared co-authors.
7. Digital sequences must be able to be run on a Windows computer with no additional software requirements.
The sequence should be programmed to return to the desktop at the end.
8. The decisions of the judge(s) are final and binding.
