Conditions of Entry

1. These rules and conditions relate only to this year's annual Audio Visual Competition.
2. Digital sequences will be sent to the judge before the competition and then shown on Zoom on the competition day.
3. Digital sequences must not have been entered as 35mm slides in previous AV Competitions.
4. Sequences may be retained for inclusion in the L&CPU Archive and used for publicity purposes.

Rules for competition

1. Entries must reach the L&CPU AV Competition Secretary by 24th January 2021.
2. Entries will be accepted this year directly from individual club members but must not have been shown previously in the L&CPU AV Competition.
3. There is no limit to the number of entries per club or member however they must be listed in order of priority in case the number of entries exceeds the available competition time.
4. **The duration of a sequence must not exceed 12 min.**
5. The individual sequences must have Copyright clearance for both images and music and the author obtained the necessary licenses.
6. The production must be the original work of the Author and declared co-authors.
7. Digital sequences must be able to be run on a Windows computer with no additional software requirements.
The sequence can be a .exe or MP4 file and should be programmed to return to the desktop at the end.
8. The decisions of the judge(s) are final and binding.
